The experienced multi-disciplinary team of leaders, therapists and educationalists work seamlessly together. They teach and proactively support pupils who have been subjected to adverse childhood experiences, including trauma and associated mental wellbeing difficulties, aiming to break the cycle of adversity.

They work with children who are anxious and may have been out of education for a period of time, who needs extra support to reintegrate them back into learning and school life.

The curriculum is individually developed around the child or young person in order for them to achieve success and gain the skills and qualifications needed for them to move on to the next phase of their life. They also offer a range of qualifications including Entry Levels, Functional Skills, GCSE's and BTEC vocational qualifications.

The environment and teaching approaches are bespoke and tailored to ensure our children and young people thrive and can develop their self-esteem.
