Introducing Our school

Mill School Bury is an independent specialist school located in the heart of Bury, offering places to children from across Greater Manchester and Lancashire. We offer a calm and safe environment where pupils are happy and thrive in their school.

Our school supports children aged 7 to 17 years with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) who may be struggling to keep up with the pace of work losing confidence or struggling with the overwhelming sensory environment of their mainstream school.

Children at Mill School Bury will have a primary need of autism, although not necessarily a diagnosis. We also help children who have been out of education for a period, to positively re-engage in education.

Our Curriculum

At Mill School Bury, staff and pupils learn and grow together as a community. We follow the National Curriculum and believe in teaching our pupils how to review, reflect, and evaluate their learning experiences.

Every child in our school will have a curriculum designed specifically for them. Following initial assessments our team will create a personalised and creative curriculum tailored to match each child's specific academic, social, emotional and sensory needs whilst also considering their passions and interests.

Pupils will join classes of up to 6, which are supported by a teacher and teaching assistant. The environment at Mill School Bury has been built from the ground up to support our pupils to thrive in education. Our learning spaces feature sensory lighting, muted colour schemes, individual workstations and visual timetables.

The school is also equipped with the very latest in educational technological, including a rebound room, Immersive space, and multi-sensory equipment. Outdoor education plays an important and popular part of the curriculum at Mill School Bury. The fantastic outdoor spaces include Multi Use Games Area, horticulture garden, forest school area and bush craft.

Our Therapeutic Approach

Children benefit from an integrated therapeutic approach at our school. The onsite therapists (SaLT and OT), supported by a visiting Educational Psychologist, embed a range of whole school approaches which create a positive and inclusive environment. The team also design and deliver personalised therapy interventions to individuals and groups to meet needs on children's EHCPs'.

Music therapy, Lego therapy and Draw and Talk Therapy are also offered as part of the Mill School Bury Therapy offer.
