## Introducing Our school



### Who We Are

We are an eclectic mix of staff who together have a wealth of experience working with pupils of all ages, predominantly in primary schools. On our team we have teachers, EYFS specialists, HLTAs, TAs – many of whom have extensive experience of working with pupils with SEN, clinical staff (Assistant EP, SALT and OT) who deliver high quality clinical interventions, mentors, a Forest School practitioner and senior support/pastoral staff who lead on developing and delivering our nurture curriculum.

### What We Offer

We offer primary provision in a small school setting within the lovely Warwickshire countryside. Learning by stage, not age, our pupils are placed in classes that will allow them to effectively access learning which is delivered in the most appropriate way for their needs. Pupils of all primary ages are welcome and we have three stages, one of which is set up for those pupils working within the EYFS or as part of a continuous provision, this is staffed with adults who have extensive experience supporting pupils in the younger age ranges.

### Our Curriculum

We wholeheartedly believe that every child who attends our school should be given the opportunity to access a broad and balanced curriculum, similar to their mainstream peers.

Our curriculum covers all of the National Curriculum subjects and promotes academic progress, however all learning is underpinned by the nurturing heart of our provision. Most recently we have developed the

following areas of our curriculum:

- Early readers and phonics
- Progress and challenge in Maths
- Our PSHE curriculum
- Our RE curriculum
- Our English curriculum

Our academic curriculum is supplemented with:

- Forest school at least weekly for all pupils
- Swimming
- Zones of regulation
- Clinical interventions
- Holistic interventions

The school currently has input from a Speech and Language Therapist, Occupational Therapist and a team of Educational Psychologists. The focus of any therapeutic support is to help the children to reach their learning potential and give them the best opportunities to develop skills for secondary school.
