Integrated therapeutic support

Integrated therapeutic support is embedded across the school. Speech and Language and Occupational Therapists will work closely with teaching staff to provide a cohesive, whole-school approach to supporting pupil development. Where required, they will provide targeted and group interventions, ensuring pupils receive the support they need to progress in their learning.
