Silverways School opened in June 2021. The school is a safe space for learners with autism to flourish and thrive. When children leave Silverways at 16 they will have gained GCSEs or alternative qualifications preparing them for sixth form, college or an apprenticeship.

Every child at Silverways benefits from our low-arousal enabling environment and universal therapeutic curriculum, supported by our Speech and Language Therapist (SaLT), Occupational Therapist (OT), Educational Psychologist (EP) and Psychotherapist

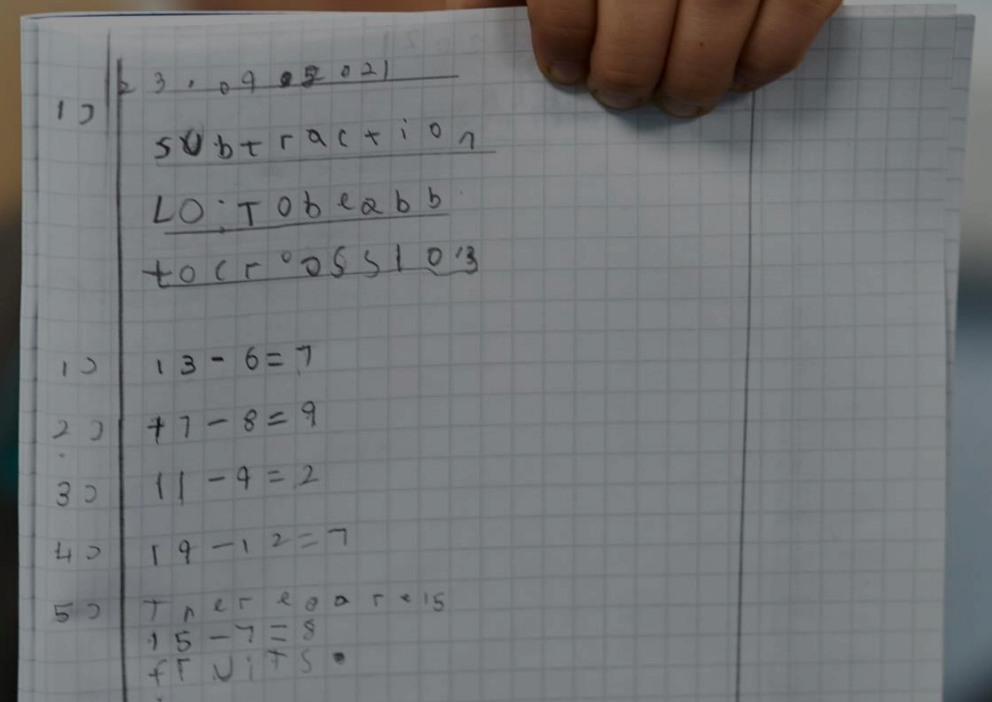
Our Ethos and Values

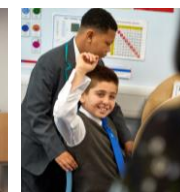

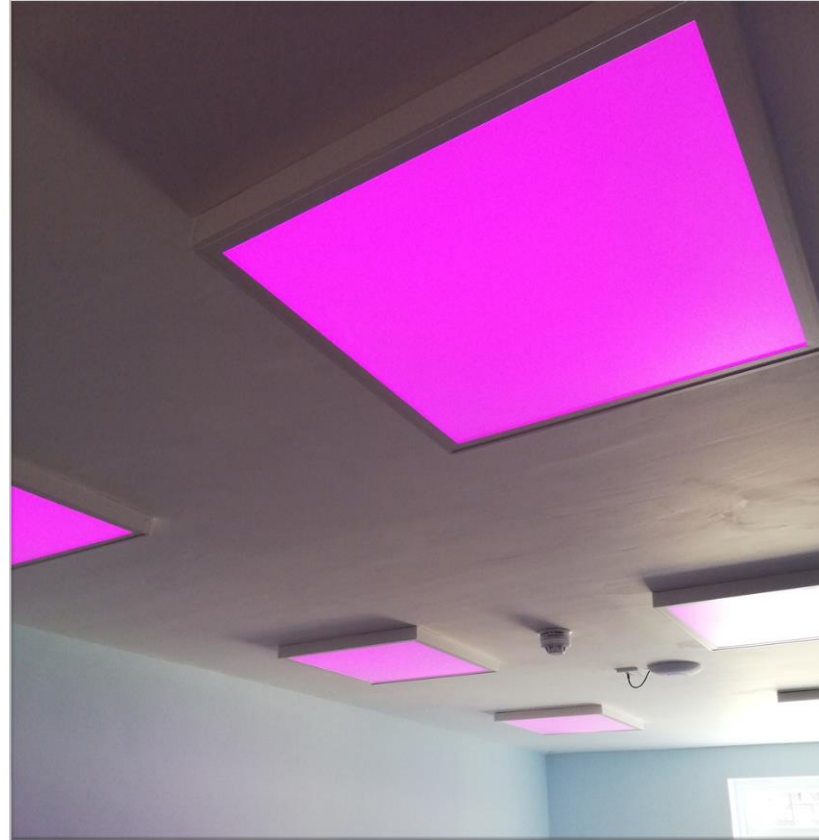

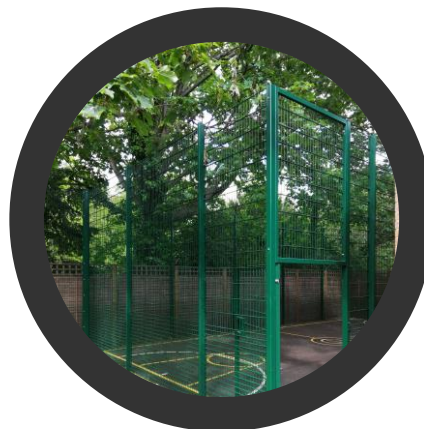
Enabling Environment

Most of our classrooms are equipped with sensory lighting - an feature of our low arousal environment which can be adapted to support sensory integration for our learners. The school hall and KS2 breakout space are equipped with noise absorbing panels to reduce sound reverberation.

Outdoor Area

During breaks, we encourage students to engage in physical activity and make the most of our outdoor facilities. You can enjoy the trim trail, use the outdoor gym equipment, or take advantage of our Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA).

For KS2, physical education (PE) lessons, take place in our outdoor; KS3 & KS4 students have access to some of the sports facilities at Enfield Grammar School for their PE lessons.

General Information



Lunch

Pupils are provided with healthy meals and snacks freshly prepared by our school chef and in accordance with the school meals standards set out by the government. Meals and snacks are provided free of charge.

Uniform

Blazers, tank tops, ties and PE kits are provided by the school and can be collected from Reception on collection day. You will receive a notification for this.

Mobile Phones

Phones should not be used during school hours. All phones and devices are handed in to Reception for safekeeping on arrival and collected at the end of the school day.

Jewelry

No jewelry is to be worn in school apart from a wristwatch and a maximum of two small plain stud earrings. Valuables must not be brought into school. The school accepts no responsibility for students' personal possessions including money, watches and jewelry.

Make-up

In the interests of high health and safety standards, students must not wear nail polish, false nails or extensions of any kind. Students must not wear makeup under any circumstances.

Vandalism

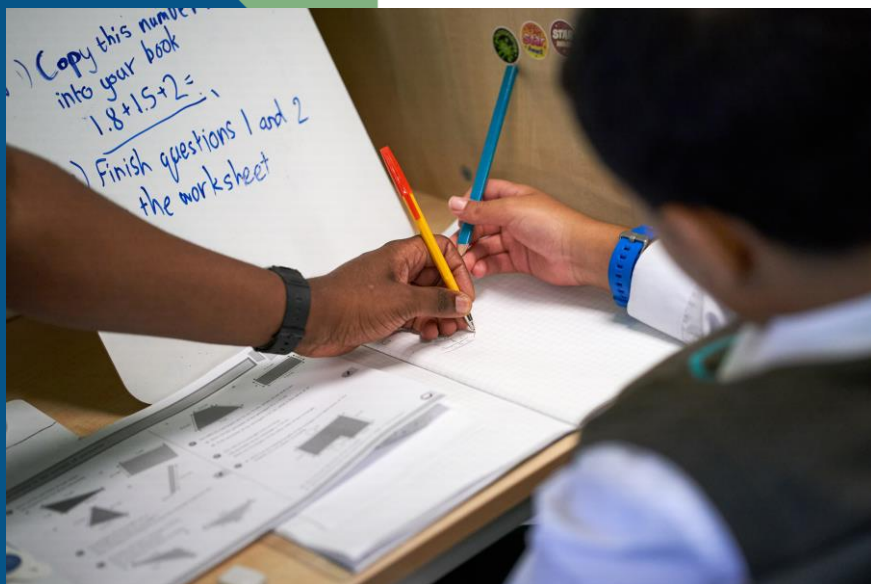
Silverways School is a safe space for all learners and for this reason we take vandalism very seriously. Any act of vandalism will lead to a meeting with the child and parents and the cost of repairing the damage will be extended to the child/family, in accordance with our behaviour policy.

Smoking & Vaping

Smoking or vaping is strictly forbidden on school premises and when travelling to and from school.

Chewing Gum, sweets and snacks

Chewing gum and sweets are not permitted on school premises. Snacks are provided to children during the school day. If children travelling long distances are provided with snacks for the journey home, they should be handed into the school office in the morning and collected at home time.
